Trans Harm Reduction (THR) is a volunteer-run, grassroots organisation supporting Trans people in Ireland and Scotland to manage the risks associated with self-medicating. Their Trans healthcare fund covers costs for GP visits, obtaining blood tests and buying injection supplies. Donations cover the cost of buying these supplies. They also use donations to pay for testing HRT sources commonly used by Trans people who are self-medicating. Testing HRT costs approximately €300 per sample. It is a valuable harm-reduction measure which will allow us to identify unsafe sources.

Gaining access to safe, reliable and affordable healthcare for Trans people in the UK and Ireland is extremely difficult and access to medical transition is an uphill battle in the current climate. Trans Harm Reduction offers peer support, advice and to those who choose it and access to the necessary tools for self-medication.
